2018 DC-Area Distribution Summary

This summary shows how we distributed our two DC-area guides plus our Special CFC Section in *Recreation News*.

- Altogether, we distributed nearly 278,000 Guides and Special Sections.
 This number is print impressions, not "readership," which assumes each copy of a publication is seen by more than one person.
- More than 184,500 of our Guides and Special Sections went to federal
 and military employees. No one else comes close to this number of
 potential CFC donors. In contrast, an issue of the Post's Express daily tabloid
 goes to 29,310 federal or military employees (22% of average daily circulation of 133,320).
- More than 51,500 of our guides and Special Sections were distributed by hand, most by our own distributors outside federal buildings and at Metro stations near federal buildings.
